Jeff works in a full-time specialist Endodontic practice in Collins Street, Melbourne and teaches in the postgraduate endodontic programme and continuing education courses at the University of Melbourne. Jeff has lectured throughout Australia, Asia and New Zealand and he has published several articles in endodontic journals with particular reference to the management of fractured endodontic instruments and vital pulp therapy.

Jeff has a special interest in rotary NiTi instruments and the use of operative microscopes in endodontics, which he has used continuously and exclusively since 1999.
