

Mastering Socket Preservation

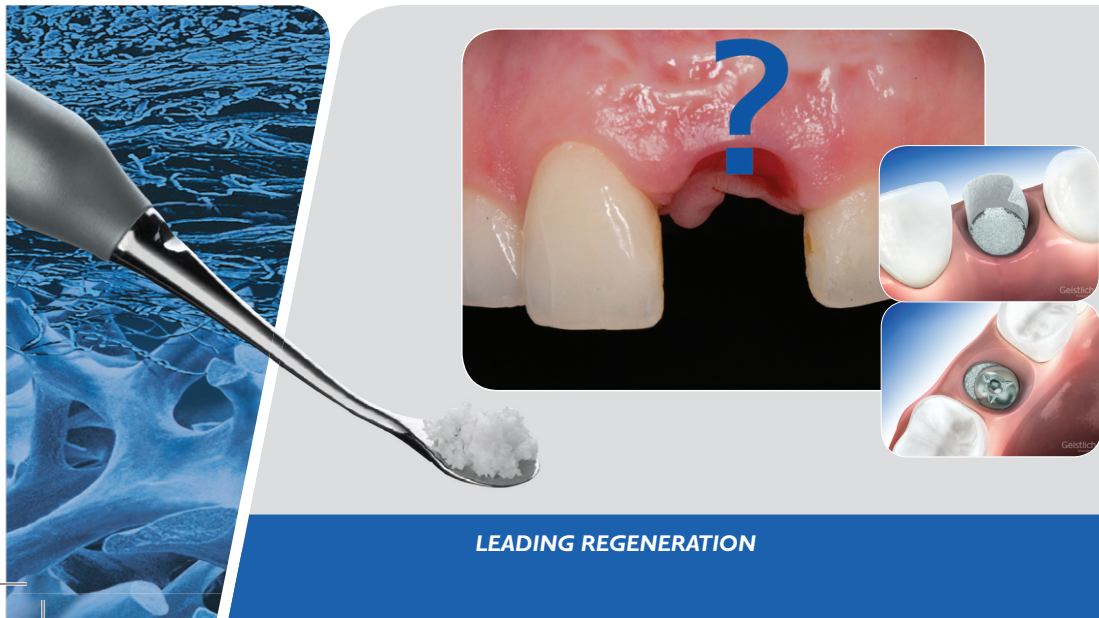

Tooth extraction or loss of a tooth can often result in alveolar ridge resorption and soft tissue collapse, which may lead to aesthetic and functional prosthetic complications. Preservation of bone loss and soft tissue height at the time of extraction is an important procedure that can help with implant placement to ensure that restorative goals are met. Proper management also may eliminate the need for advanced ridge augmentation procedures that are sometimes required prior to implant placement.

Current evidence and literature will be discussed. Clinical cases will be shown with a step-by-step plan to ensure predictable socket preservation following tooth extraction. This will be followed by a hands on session where participants have the opportunity to practice the presented treatment concepts on pig mandibles. Atraumatic extraction techniques, harvesting soft tissue grafts for socket seal technique, membrane utilisation and suturing techniques will be included in the hands on session.
