#### Description

A convenient, reliable and consistent means of producing chlorine solutions for disinfection operations.

#### Directions

For disinfecting impressions and devices, dissolve 1 tablet in 1 litre of water (1000ppm Chlorine), using a Dentisan Impression Bath for convenience with a contact time of 5 minutes. Refer to HTM 01:05 guidance, rinse well before use. Always consult Manufacturer's directions for the material/ item to be disinfected before use to ensure suitability of product solution.

For water storage containers, use 1 tablet per 5 litres of water with a minimum contact time of 10 minutes. Rinse well before use.

For blood/ body fluid spills, use 1 tablet per 100ml of water (10,000ppm Chlorine).

Avoid contact with fabrics. Please refer to product safety datasheet before use. Use only as directed.
